Since September 2016 MRCT have been working on a pilot project with Stansted Airport to help them recycle passengers surrendered/restricted nonperishable food, drink and toiletry items when undergoing hand baggage checks.

The pilot project has been so successful that this work will continue in 2017. These items have included; tinned baked beans, tinned soups, tinned meat and fish, marmite, peanut butter, jarred pickle, top range jams and

marmalades from Buckingham Palace, Fortnum and Mason, Highgrove and Harrods. It has also included a large range of toiletries, soaps and gift sets. Once delivered to the foodbank these donations are sorted, cleaned and distributed back into the local community via foodbank satellite centres and the Bounty Club.
