It has been greatly encouraging to see the work of the Bounty Club in Harlow grow and develop as the charity continues to focus on reducing food wastage in partnership with local food companies, supermarkets and Stansted Airport.

The charity has also recently acquired the Poundland Distribution Centre, based at the

Pinnacles in Harlow, as a new community partner that provides us with a wide range of non-perishable food, toiletries and household products for distribution to local people in crisis via the Bounty Club and Harlow Foodbank.

Coordinator Trevor Stanesby, who continues to progress this work, ensuring that the surplus food we receive is directed straight back into the community.

- front-line agencies are now working in partnership with the Bounty Club
- schools are currently supported by the Bounty Club (9 primary and 1 senior)
- tonnes of surplus fresh food is picked up and distributed to front-line professional agencies each month
- 4.7 tonnes of Stansted Airport donations have been distributed to front-line professional agencies in Harlow

Surplus fresh food is currently provided by Brakes, Bidfood in Harlow and Swithenbank in Hoddesdon. Local supermarkets Tesco Metro and Lidl in Harlow are also now providing the Bounty Club with surplus food.


